



Gift of Securities Transfer Document

Security transfers from a donor's brokerage account into The Guelph Community Foundation's account:

When securities are held in a brokerage account, there is no need to transfer the actual certificates. The donor instructs the broker to transfer the securities from his/her account into the charity's account. The fair market value will be determined as of the closing price on the day the securities are received by The Guelph Community Foundation's financial institution. The Guelph Community Foundation issues official receipts for income tax purposes (charitable registration #86727 8350 RR0001). Please contact us regarding estate gifts.
