participate in camp activities. We have granted over \$117,000 to almost 30 different organizations to help provide camping experiences for children and youth.

In 2013 we helped send over 175 youth to local camps. With over \$3,500 in funding since 2011, East Wellington Community Services had this to say following the success of last year's camp, "We are extremely grateful for the grant received for this program so that we could help families and their children who would otherwise not have an opportunity to experience a summer camp, due to their personal circumstance. With the increase in funding received we were able to send even more children to camp this year and we are so appreciative of being able to provide support to our clients' families with our Kids to Camp program.
