In 2018, the granting criteria for charitable organizations seeking funding will create and submit an application that meets both of the following:

1. Is categorized under one (or more) of the following areas, as highlighted in the 2018 Vital Signs report:
 - a. Education
 - b. Health
 - c. Community Vitality
 - d. Environment
 - e. Leisure, Culture and Recreation
